NJ BULLETIN 04-15 PROVIDES COMMERCIAL PPA EDITION BUYER'S GUIDE FOR INDIVIDUALLY OWNED PRIVATE PASSENGER AUTOS WRITTEN ON COMMERCIAL POLICIES

BACKGROUND

Regulation N.J.A.C. 11:3-15 requires that a Buyer's Guide, Coverage Selection Form and the New Jersey Automobile Insurance Consumer Bill of Rights be issued to individually owned private passenger autos written on a commercial auto policy.

The New Jersey Department of Banking and Insurance recently issued Bulletin 04-15 which provided guidance to insurers who write such vehicles on commercial policies. The Department has also created a "Commercial PPA Edition" of the Buyer's Guide that insurers may use.

APPLICATION TO COMMERCIAL RISKS

The Bulletin provides the that requirement to furnish the Buyer's Guide, Coverage Selection Form and Consumer Bill of Rights does not apply to "private passenger types" which are owned by a corporation, partnership or any other entity, other than an individual or husband or wife, and are rated in the commercial auto manual.
