## **NJ BULLETIN 05-19 REVISES FILING TRANSMITTAL DOCUMENT REQUIREMENT**

### **BACKGROUND**

The New Jersey Department of Banking and Insurance recently issued Bulletin 05-19 which advises filers that the MARS 001 filing form will be replaced by the NAIC Uniform Property and Casualty Transmittal Document.

This is the filing form used by the Insurance Departments in most other states.

### **EFFECTIVE DATE**

As of September 15, 2005 all companies should use the NAIC Transmittal Document in lieu of the MARS 001 when submitting filings to the Department of Banking and Insurance.

We will use the appropriate forms when submitting filings for MSO® or on behalf of individual companies.

The New Jersey Department will propose amendments to the Administrative Code to substitute the NAIC Transmittal Document for the references to the MARS 001. Until such amendments are adopted, the Department will continue to accept the MARS 001 form.
