REVISIONS TO COMMERCIAL INLAND MARINE ENDORSEMENTS

BACKGROUND	Commercial Inland Marine endorsements MIM 102 and MIM 103 define Computer Hacking. We have revised these endorsements in order to keep up to date with current terminology. Additional references to types of unwanted intrusions have been added to the Computer Hacking definition. The revisions are for clarification purposes and represent no reduction in coverage.
MSO[®] ACTION	MSO has amended endorsements MIM 102 and MIM 103 to update the definition of Computer Hacking. The revised language will be added to the other MSO Commercial Lines forms as well.
EFFECTIVE DATE	Endorsements MIM 102 and MIM 103 are non-filed and may be used immediately.
