## **MD REVISES REPORTING FORMS FOR COMPLAINTS OF FAILING TO ACT IN GOOD FAITH**

### **BACKGROUND**

In October 2007, we informed you that Sections 3-1701 of the Courts and Judicial Proceedings Article and Section 27-1001 of the Insurance Article were enacted into law and became effective on October 1, 2007. This law deals with actions against insurers claiming failure to act in good faith. The Maryland Insurance Administration (MIA) issued Bulletin 07-15 which provided insurers with the forms to comply with the filing of such complaints.

The MIA has recently issued Bulletin 08-02 which includes new reporting forms that replace the reporting forms shown in Exhibits 2 and 3 of Bulletin 07-15.

### **COMPANY ACTION**

You should follow the reporting instructions and use the new forms as provided in Bulletin 08-02.
