## **NEW JERSEY REQUESTS INFORMATION ON DISASTER RESPONSE PREPARATION PLANS**

- BACKGROUND** The Department of Banking and Insurance (DOBI) recently issued Bulletin No. 10-06 which applies to insurers with an aggregate of \$20,000,000 or more in direct written premiums covering property risks. The DOBI is interested in knowing the extent such insurers have activated a Disaster Response Preparation Plan (DRPR) or a catastrophe Plan (CAT Plan) following the March 12-15 Nor'easter.
- COMPANY ACTION** The DOBI is requesting insurers to provide a brief description of the aspects of their DRPR or Cat Plan activated in response to the Nor'easter, or to advise the DOBI that this type of plan was not activated.
