ELECTRONIC AGGRESSION EXCLUSION INTRODUCED FOR PERSONAL LINES PROGRAM IN PENNSYLVANIA

BACKGROUND	Electronic aggression is the term used by the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) to incorporate all types of bullying, harassment and other types of violence that are done electronically. Such activities are intentional acts and never meant to be covered under a standard insurance policy.
MSO ACTION	MSO developed electronic exclusion provisions to be incorporated in the state mandatory endorsement as well as the personal umbrella form and endorsement.
FORMS CHANGES	This revision introduces new versions of the state mandatory endorsement (MPL 99 01 12), stand alone personal umbrella coverage form (MPL 100 01 12) and endorsement version (MPL 180 01 12).
FUTURE CHANGES	Endorsements to provide optional coverage for Electronic Aggression will be filed.
EFFECTIVE DATE	The revision is effective March 1, 2012 in Pennsylvania. The filing is pending in New Jersey and will be filed in additional states shortly.
