AUTO MINIMUM LIABILITY LIMITS INCREASE IN OH

BACKGROUND	Ohio House Bill 278, effective December 22, 2013, amends Section 4509.01 of the Ohio Revised Code to increase the minimum financial responsibility limits from \$12,500/\$25,000/\$7,500 to \$25,000/\$50,000/\$25,000. The combined single limit to correspond to this minimum is \$75,000. Please note that the Uninsured Motorist Property Damage Liability limit remains \$7,500.
MSO ACTION	We filed and have received approval to introduce Liability increased limits factors and Uninsured Motorists rates for a \$75,000 limit in the Commercial Auto Manual.
COMPANY ACTION	As this is a retrospective effective date, companies will need to ensure no policies bearing effective dates of December 22, 2013, and later have been issued using the former minimum financial responsibility limits.
EFFECTIVE DATE	December 22, 2013
