NEW MAILING AND DELIVERY REQUIREMENTS IN MARYLAND

BACKGROUND

Maryland Senate Bill 977 allows insurers to comply with mailing and delivery requirements for notices of cancellation, nonrenewal, premium increase and reduction in coverage by using “First-class Mail Tracking” for many P&C lines of Business.

MSO ACTION

We have updated the mandatory endorsements to comply with this law.

The following mandatory endorsements have been updated with an 04 15 edition date:

- MCM 840 - (Garage, House of Worship, Special Contractors, General Liability and Commercial Property)
- BU 0840 - (Businessowners)
- MCL 788 - (Commercial Umbrella)
- MCA 840 - (Commercial Auto)
- MPL 108 - (Personal Umbrella)
- MPL 120 - (Homeowners, Personal Inland Marine, Dwelling Property and Dwelling Liability)

COMPANY ACTION

Each company must decide if they are going to adopt, delay adoption or not adopt this revision.

If a company elects not to adopt or to delay adoption after the effective date they should notify the Insurance Department of their intent. MSO is available to act on a company’s behalf upon request of the company.

EFFECTIVE DATE

August 1, 2015
