NEW YORK WORKERS' COMPENSATION LAW CHANGE

BACKGROUND

Legislation amending The New York Workers' Compensation Law Section 50 (d) will require any out-of-state employer to provide a full, statutory New York State workers' compensation insurance policy for any employees working in New York.

An employer has a full, statutory New York policy when New York is listed in Item 3A on the Information Page of the employer's workers' compensation policy. Also, if New York is listed in Item 3.C of the Information Page, then the Other States Insurance provision of the workers' compensation policy applies.

EFFECTIVE DATE

The new law is effective September 9, 2007
