NEW RESTAURANT BOP PROGRAM APPROVED IN PENNSYLVANIA

BACKGROUND

We have developed a new niche market Restaurant program. The new coverage endorsement (BU 04 20 09 09) provides many coverage enhancements designed to meet the needs of the Restaurant insured. The endorsement may be attached to either the BU 04 01 (all perils) or the BU 04 02 (named perils) BOP policy. Separate Decs Supplements (BU 04 21 09 09 and BU 04 24 09 09) provide the special limits. A three page manual supplement includes the rules and rates. The rules in the BOP Manual apply unless a different rule is in the supplement.

We have filed and received approval of the Restaurant program in Pennsylvania. The filing is pending in New Jersey and will be filed in all of the MSO® states.

EFFECTIVE DATE

January 1, 2010 - Pennsylvania

PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

The new program includes many coverage enhancements to make it competitive with other specialty programs on the market. The main coverage extensions, with optional increases available, are:
