



NEW JERSEY REQUESTS INFORMATION ON DISASTER RESPONSE PREPARATION PLANS

BACKGROUND

The Department of Banking and Insurance (DOBI) recently issued Bulletin No. 10-06 which applies to insurers with an aggregate of \$20,000,000 or more in direct written premiums covering property risks. The DOBI is interested in knowing the extent such insurers have activated a Disaster Response Preparation Plan (DRPR) or a catastrophe Plan (CAT Plan) following the March 12-15 Nor'easter.

COMPANY ACTION

The DOBI is requesting insurers to provide a brief description of the aspects of their DRPR or Cat Plan activated in response to the Nor'easter, or to advise the DOBI that this type of plan was not activated.

DUE DATE The response should be sent by April 3, 2010.
