ALL PURPOSE VEHICLE ENDORSEMENT INTRODUCED IN OHIO

- BACKGROUND** Ohio HB 2 requires that “all purpose” vehicles as defined by Ohio Statute 4519.10 are to be registered for use, regardless of where the vehicle is used.
- MSO ACTION** We filed and received approval of optional Personal Lines endorsement, MPL 169 - All Purpose Vehicle Coverage, in Ohio which amends The Incidental Motorized Land Vehicle and Trailers Coverage by extending Coverage E to include bodily injury and property damage arising out of all purpose vehicles subject to motor vehicle registration that are not owned by the insured or on the insured premises at the time of the occurrence. All purpose vehicles has also been added as a defined term.
- EFFECTIVE DATE** March 1, 2011.
