



MARYLAND ISSUES BULLETIN ASKING FOR REASONABLE ACCOMMODATIONS FOLLOWING HURRICANE IRENE

BACKGROUND The Maryland Insurance Administration (MIA) issued Bulletin 11-23

encouraging insurers to provide reasonable accommodations for personal auto and homeowners policyholders to avoid cancellations. This would include a grace period for premium payment. The MIA did not suggest the length for this

grace period.
