

NEW JERSEY COMMERCIAL AUTO INCREASED LIABILITY LIMITS APPROVED

BACKGROUND New Jersey has passed Bill A4292, which raises the minimum

liability coverage limit for commercial motor vehicles and autocabs (taxis) in New Jersey. Commercial motor vehicles with a gross vehicle weight rating over 26,000 lbs. and autocabs (taxis) are now required to carry at least \$1.5 million in liability coverage. Commercial vehicles with a gross vehicle weight rating 10,001 to 26,000 lbs. must have liability limits of at least

\$300,000.

State Minimum Basic Limit requirements may be satisfied by any combination of the following: commercial auto insurance policy, fleet insurance policy, commercial umbrella insurance policy, commercial excess insurance policy, or similar insurance

policy.

MSO ACTION MSO, Inc. has revised the State Provisions rule in the New

Jersey Commercial Auto Manual and Commercial Auto State Pages to include the new minimum limit requirements. Rating factors for a newly available \$1.5 million Combined Single

Limit have also been added.

COMPANY ACTION MSO subscribing companies should use the revised manual rule

and rating factors for all New Jersey Commercial Auto policies

that are issued or renewed on or after July 1, 2024.
