## **NEW TERRORISM EXCLUSION ENDORSEMENT AND RULES APPROVED IN DELAWARE AND PENNSYLVANIA**

### **BACKGROUND**

MSO, Inc. now provides an option for companies to exclude nuclear, radioactive, biological, or chemical acts of terrorism – endorsement MCM 426.

This endorsement contains stand-alone exclusionary language. It can be used on policies with terrorism loss coverage, and with policies that include other terrorism loss exclusions.

### **MSO ACTION**

MCM 426 12 24 and revised Terrorism Supplements have been filed and approved in Delaware and Pennsylvania.

MCM 426 is an optional endorsement and has no premium impact.

### **COMPANY ACTION**

These filing were made on behalf of member companies using applicable MSO programs (Businessowners, Combination Dwelling, Commercial Auto, Commercial Property, Farmowners, Garage, General Liability, House of Worship, and Special Contractors). No company action is needed to utilize MCM 426 or revised Terrorism Supplements.
